We had 185 saved and 88 baptized, PRAISE THE LORD, AMEN!!!!

Two of them stayed for the next week to teach Pastors Refreshers Course. As always the Lord filled their cup by seeing the desire of the men and hearing how much of the Bible they understand ... yes sir the Lord is Wonderful. Both of them said they want to come back. Well sure, you can't get enough of God's Jesus bumps when you know He can stir them up in you!!!!!! Some of you reading this might want to come and get some, ya know what I mean, Hallelujah, Wow!!!!

We also finished up our first trimester of Bible Institute with 13 men attending at the mission station alone. What an honor to be able to teach the words of God in truth and know they are making a

difference to a country that needs the true God of the Bible. I told you, you can get Jesus Bumps!!!!!!!

April is when we get a chance to visit churches far from our area and that is just what Kevin did as he labored in Mwinilunga some 9 hours Northwest just at the border of Congo. Lorna and I visited churches that are 2 to 4½ hours from the mission station. It is especial great to hear the testimonies of those men and women that were taught at our institutes and meet other students at the four institutes off the mission station. We get so excited to hear them answer questions from the word of God they only could know because our graduates are doing a work of and for the Lord Jesus Christ!!!!

Sunday services are seeing many dedicating their lives, joining our churches because of the teaching of the truth, desiring to come to institute or Pastors training and some getting saved at just about each service. God is so very good to this work of God and us. Thank you for your part in helping us stay here and having our lives so full of God's blessing in eternal rewards. That is for you and us, as you are just as much a part of this work as we are. You all are truly loved and appreciated!!!!

We will be coming back to the states for our second furlough in 14 years to the US. We will be available from January to about July, 2009. I am humbly asking for any assistance in the cost of the flight. We are hit very hard here with the rate of exchange, which is cutting our buying power by about 35%. The prices here are steadily going up and up as you know from the US. For example a gallon of gas is \$8.00, bread, milk, etc. has gone up and up. If the Lord moves you heart please help by sending to our home church in Plainville, CT. Please let them know it is for the furlough flight in 2009. Thank you very much for your consideration and love for us.
